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1. CALL FIRST

To start the process for obtaining legal representation as quickly as possible, we recommend calling our intake line: (312) 332-1624

FIVE EASY STEPS

2. ASK TO SPEAK WITH OUR INTAKE SPECIALIST

Our intake specialist will take the relevant information and determine whether CVLS can help you with your problem. If it appears that you meet our basic guidelines, we will make an appointment.

4. WHAT YOU SHOULD BRING

You should bring any court papers, leases, contracts or other paperwork that is related to your legal matter.

Also, please bring the names and addresses of the people involved with your problem.

3. BE ON TIME FOR YOUR APPOINTMENT

If you are unable to keep your appointment, please call (312) 332-1624 and let us know.

This will help us to serve as many people as possible. We will reschedule you for the next available appointment.

5. WE WILL NOTIFY YOU

After your interview and once we have all of the information we need from you, a CVLS staff attorney will review your case.

We will let you know if we can help you by sending you a letter to the address you gave us. We will try to let you know within four weeks of your interview.

If you have a court date before we contact you, you MUST attend on your own. Tell the Judge you are trying to find an attorney, and ask for a continuance of your case. We cannot guarantee that a Judge will give you a continuance.
